REVISED SYSTEM - NEW PERMIT

THE HAM CAR PARK - Resident Parking Regulations

Introduction.

The Ham and the Ham car park are owned and maintained by Dittisham Parish Council on behalf, and for the use, of the parishioners of Dittisham and its visitors. In 2003 the Parish Council adopted a resolution to change revenue collection at the car park from 'honesty boxes' to a metered 'Pay and Display' system, with the aim of providing sufficient revenue to self fund all required maintenance on The Ham (grass cutting, hedge, tree and ditch maintenance, car park surfacing, children's play area, etc.). Any additional revenue collected to be used to fund projects directly related to, and benefiting, the Parish of Dittisham.

To satisfy and maintain covenant origins relevant to the area, all permanently resident Dittisham parishioners may park their cars on The Ham car park free of charge. The Parish Council has also decided that non-resident homeowners within the parish may also enjoy free parking of one car only. This system commenced in February 2004 but has recently been revised.

EFFECTIVE FROM 1ST JANUARY 2012 EXISTING GREEN PERMITS ARE NO LONGER VALID A RED PERMIT MUST BE DISPLAYED ON VEHICLE

Regulations - Parking Permits

- In order to monitor and regulate use of the car park, Dittisham Parish Council issues free car parking permits to households entitled to free car parking on The Ham car park. All permanently resident property owners (listed on the current register of electors) within the parish may each receive one permit. A second permit can be requested, per property, on application to the Parish Council. (Contact: M Faulkner: 01803 722549)
 All other properties within the parish (second homes, holiday lets etc.,) will receive one permit per property, for use of the property owner.
- Permits are issued for the **sole use** of the property's resident household, or the property owner(s), and are **not transferable**, i.e. persons renting properties for holiday use, short term lease, and the like shall not be allowed use of the permit for their personal free parking.
- 3 A weekly pass is available on application: see car park notice board for details.
- 4 Permits must be **properly and permanently fixed to the vehicle's front windscreen** and be easily visible.
- All car owners using The Ham car park are required to pay a parking fee, unless a **RED** parking permit is properly displayed on their vehicle.
