This consultation is the second stage of consultation aimed at reaching out further and to ask more specific questions.


A questionnaire was created and circulated via the following methods:

Number of responses = 94



Age Group of Users




Reason for Visit




Usage of the Ham




Favourite Play Activities




Replace or Expand Facilities
